

## **Child Safe Commitment Statement**

Positive Solutions upholds children's right to safety in all aspects of their lives. We are committed to ensuring that we maintain child-safe practices across our organisation which are guided by the implementation of the National Principals for Child Safe Organisations.

- 1. Child safety and wellbeing is embedded in organisational leadership, governance and culture.
- 2. Children and young people are informed about their rights, participate in decisions affecting them, are treated with respect and dignity and are taken seriously.
- 3. Families and communities are informed and involved in promoting child safety and wellbeing.
- 4. Equity is upheld, and diverse needs and cultural backgrounds respected in policy and practice.
- 5. People working with children and young people are suitable and supported to reflect child safety and wellbeing values in practice.
- 6. Processes to respond to complaints and concerns are child focused.
- 7. Staff and volunteers are equipped with the knowledge, skills and awareness to keep children and young people safe through ongoing education and training.
- 8. Physical and online environments promote safety and wellbeing while minimising the opportunity for children and young people to be harmed.
- 9. Implementation of the national child safe principles is regularly reviewed and improved.
- 10. Policies and procedures document how the organisation is safe for children and young people; and how complaints or concerns for child safety within Positive Solutions are managed.
